FLÖSSERTOUR

Narrow paths meandering through the UNESCO Palatinate Forest Biosphere Reserve offer great views of several massive rock formations like the Fleckstein with its narrow stone arch. Another high-light is the historic Trift complex (log driving facility) in the Storrachtal.

The **Flößertour** near Lemberg (Pfalz) has been awarded the **Premium Hiking Trail** seal by the German Hiking Institute in Marburg.

Many different assessment criteria are taken into account during the inspection, which guarantees an optimal hiking experience. The criteria include the paths, user-friendly markings, the experience of nature and the landscape, an interesting and varied route and relevant sights.

The certification is valid for three years. During this time, the trail may be advertised with the Europe-wide protected seal for premium hiking trails.

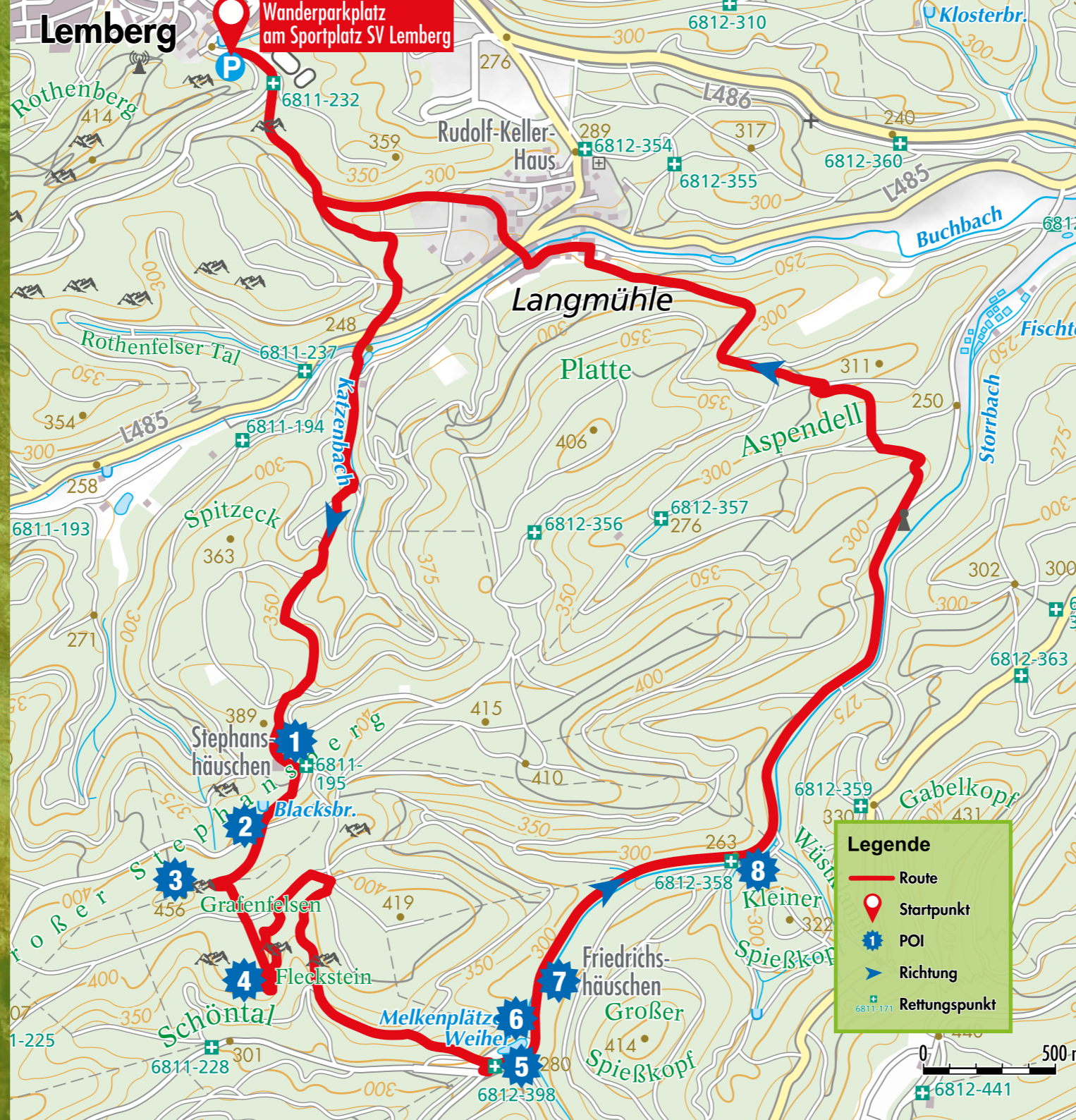
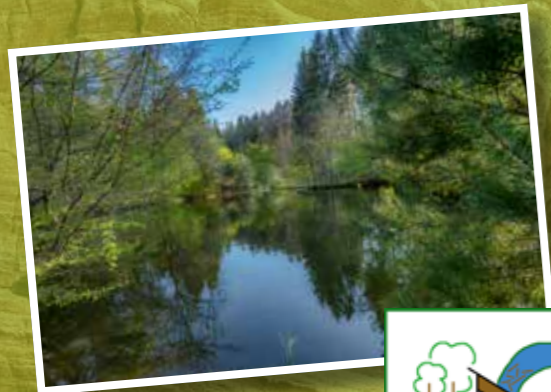
ROUTE DESCRIPTION

The tour starts in the **SV Lemberg's parking lot** next to the athletic field. Just follow the signs down a narrow path, across state road L485.

After crossing the small Salzbach creek bridge you will enter the forest. The first high light of the tour is the **Stephanshäuschen 1**, next to a beautiful oak tree, which has been designated as a natural monument. The adjacent seating area is a great place for a break.

The tour continues past the **Blacksbrunnen 2** to the **Grafenfelsen 3**. After climbing the iron staircase you will have a beautiful view over the area.

From there it is not far to the impressive rock formation of the **Fleckstein 4**. The narrow path partially circles the Fleckstein, continues beneath a rock arch, and follows the rock wall to the Rentnerpfad.



The wider Rentnerpfad takes you to the **Melkenplätzer Weiher 5** in the Storrbachtal. **6** Starting point at the rafters' station in the Storrbachtal.

In the valley you will see the **Friedrichshäuschen 7**, the former Trift Canal and finally the low dam for the log-driving canal, the **Philippsklause (Wüstklamm) 8**. From there the trail heads back uphill, into the forest, to the little neighborhood town of Langmühle, past the Rudolf Keller House back to the SV Lemberg parking lot.
