Premium Hiking Trail SANDHASENTOUR

SANDHASENTOUR

This tour is in a lesser-known part of the UNESCO Palatinate Forest Biosphere Reserve. After hiking through mountains and valleys it offers a great view from the impressive rock massif Krappenfelsen. Another sight worth seeing is the church of St. Stephanus with its medieval church tower.

The **Sandhasentour** near Trulben has been awarded the **Premium Hiking Trail** seal by the German Hiking Institute in Marburg.

Many different assessment criteria are taken into account during the inspection, which guarantees an optimal hiking experience. The criteria include the paths, user-friendly markings, the experience of nature and the landscape, an interesting and varied route and relevant sights.

The certification is valid for three years. During this time, the trail may be advertised with the Europe-wide protected seal for premium hiking trails.

The website www.wanderinstitut.de provides information on all certified premium trails.



ROUTE DESCRIPTION

The tour begins in the center of Trulben, at the **Trualbhalle parking lot 1** (Note: motorhome parking spaces are available). After a short hike through the town, and a brief climb up a narrow forest path, you will hike on a small street through a meadow to the **St. Wendelinus-Kapelle 2**.

From there a narrow downhill path leads to the **Felsendusche 3** then to the **Franzosenkopf 4** and finally to the idyllic **Trualbquelle 5**. The tour continues through the „Große Tälchen“ back to Trulben, where you will start hiking up to the **Krappenfelsen 7**. Make sure that you take a few minutes to explore the **Krappenhöhle 6**.

Once you reach the viewing platform at the top of the Krappenfelsen, take a break in the seating area and enjoy the excellent view over Trulben.



You will continue to climb until a narrow path leads downhill, over a small stream, back to Trulben.

In Trulben, on your way to the Trualbhalle parking lot, you will pass the **Pfarrkirche St. Stephanus 8** with its medieval church tower.
